GRAND KNIGHTS REPORT

Brothers,

I wanted to start off by thanking everyone who participated in the Installation for Father Jason. He was extremely grateful for the show of support and friendship. I want to thank Faithful Navigator Tom Knechtel and all of members of the Padre Pio Assembly for turning out and dressed- it was very impressive!!! I want to reiterate the commitment of our officers regarding everyone's health and wellbeing as we struggle with issues and concerns of Covid- 19. As you are aware, we did have a member test positive shortly after the Installation Mass. We made sure that we communicated the situation quickly to ensure everyone was alerted to the situation. Additionally, we cancelled the Thursday meeting and rescheduled our Memorial Mass on the side of caution.

I feel it is important to provide my "Report Card' to the Council as December is 6 months into my term as Grand Knight. On my first night, I spoke about focusing on these four items:

Building a strong relationship with our Parish and Clergy: This started with our new Pastor, Father Jason.
